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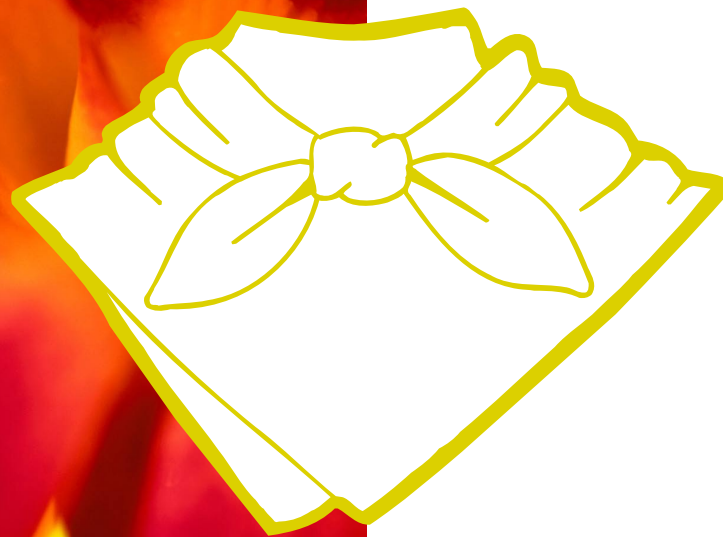
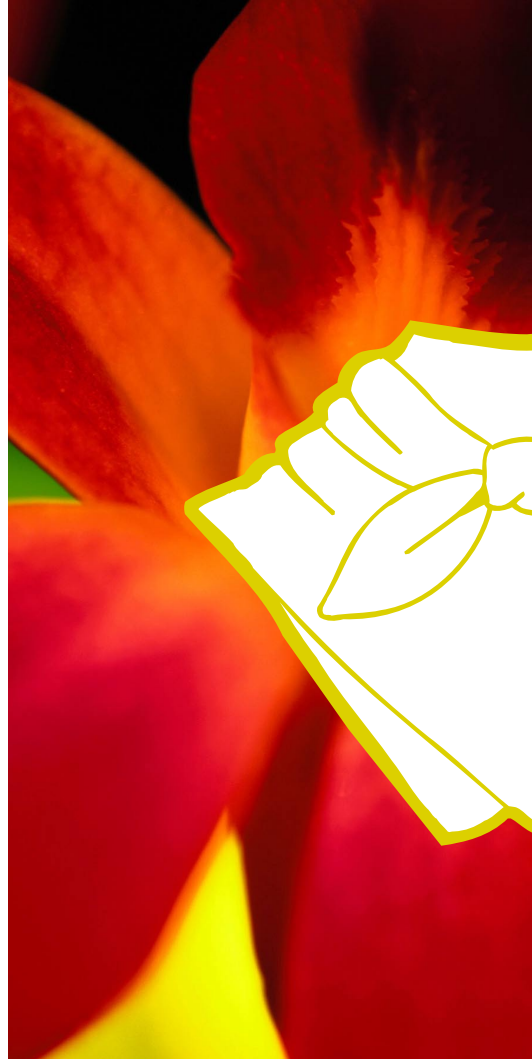
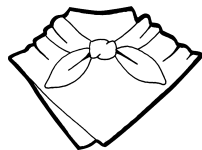
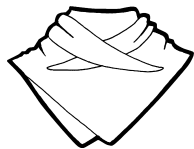
How to Tie a Scarf

A nicely tied scarf will be seen by everyone. With this detail of silk an old dress will suddenly become like new.

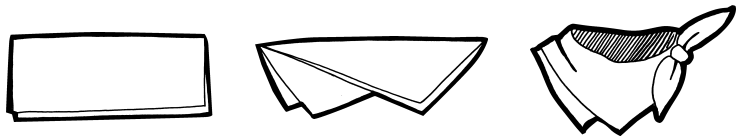
The world is full of various ways to wear the scarf. We sincerely hope that our guide 'How to tie a scarf' will inspire you, too, to play with your scarf.

The Triangle...

Fold a square scarf into a triangle. Place it round your neck so that the corners are at the back. Drape the scarf in front. Turn the corners to the front and make a knot. The knot can also be tied under the triangle. To form a hood collar turn the triangle over the knot and fold it nicely.

The Triangular Collar... Fold a square scarf once. Take hold of its corners diagonally and fold it once more so that one side is straight and the other angled. Lay the scarf with the straight side on your shoulders and tie the ends. The knot can be placed either in front, on one shoulder or back.

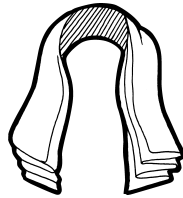

The Folded Collar...

Fold a square scarf into 10 cm broad folds. Place the folded scarf around your neck so that the ends are equally long.

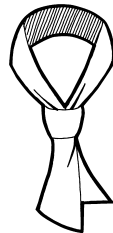
Keeping the folds in place, tie a knot. Tuck the upper end of the scarf backwards front to form a 'collar'. Tuck the other end the opposite way, in other words lift it up first and then tuck it around downwards.



Folded Collar

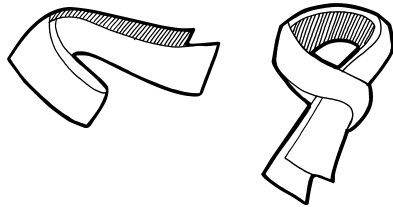
The Tie... Fold a long or square scarf round your neck so that one end is longer than the other. Turn the longer end backwards to front and tuck it from the upside through the loop. Draw the loop tight and straighten the scarf.

Another way to form a tie is to make a loose knot at one end of the scarf about 15 cm from the end. Tuck the right-hand end through this knot and draw until it is longer than the left-hand end. Draw tight by holding both ends of the scarf.

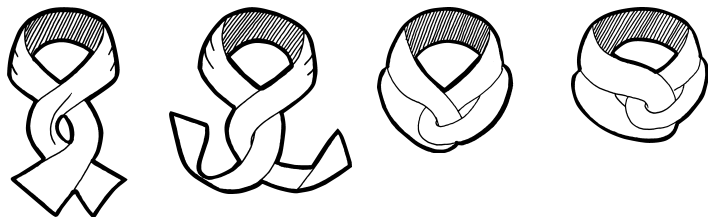
The Loop.... Fold a long scarf in two and place it around your neck. Tuck both ends through the loop and draw tight or loos. Another type of loop is formed by folding one end of the scarf, for instance, under your foot and winding the scarf into a tight roll holding the other end of it tightly. Take hold of the middle of the roll with one hand and both ends with the other. Hold the scarf in a firm grip so that the roll doesn't slip. Let go of the middle, and the scarf will turn once more. Lay the scarf around your neck and tie as above.



Loop

The Necklace...

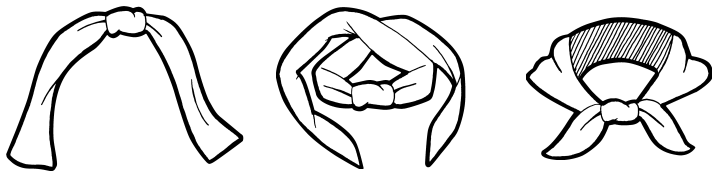
Place a long scarf around your neck so that the ends are equally long in front. Twist both ends twice around each other. Tie in knot back.

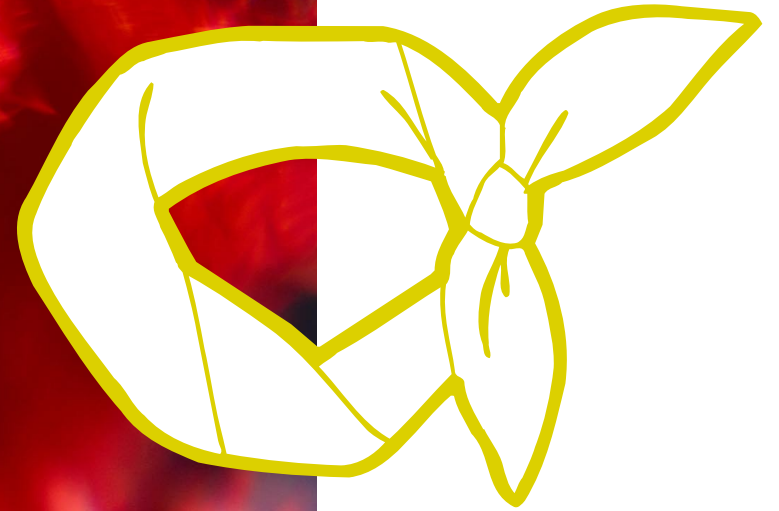
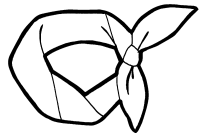
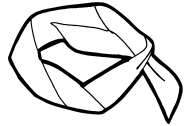
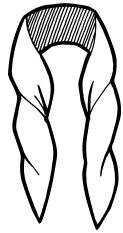
The Bow tie...

••• Tie a loose knot in the middle of a long scarf. Lay the scarf around your neck so that the knot is middle front. Turn the ends around your neck and back front. Tuck both ends through the knot and draw tight holding both ends.



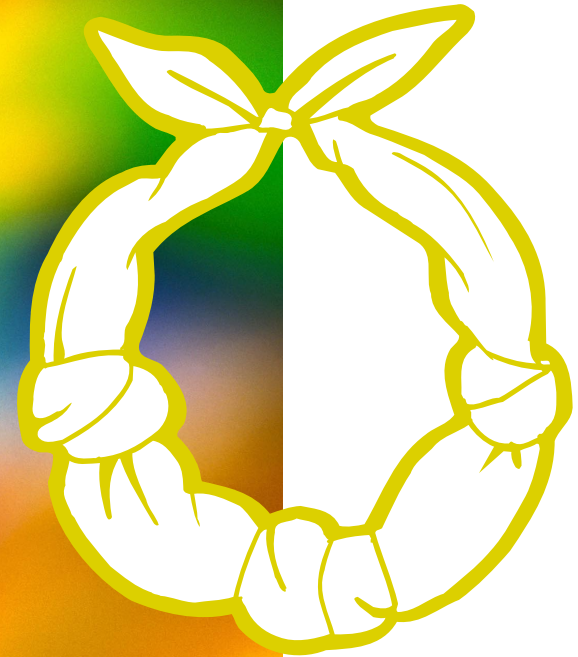
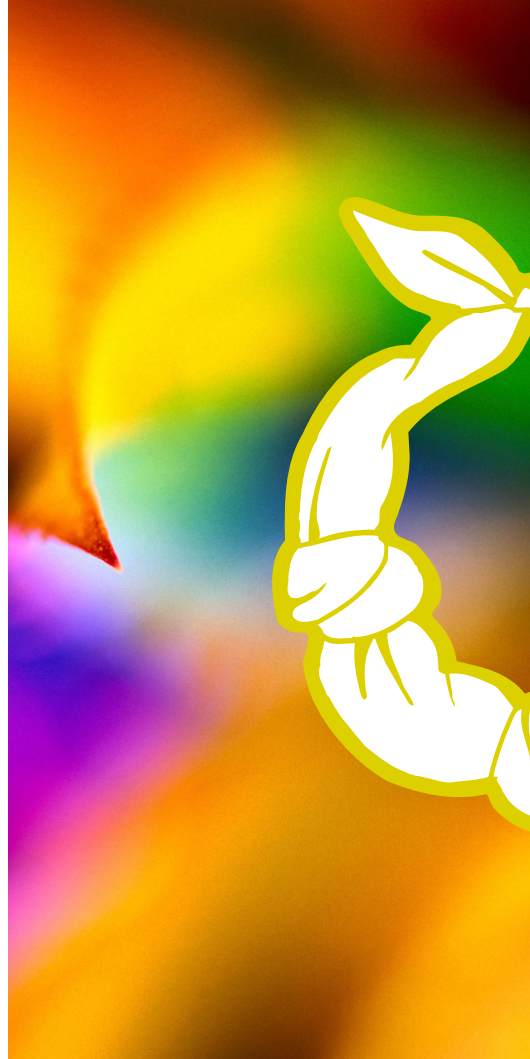
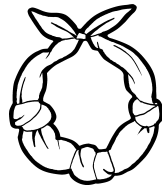
Bow tie

The Screw...Fold a square scarf into a narrow strip. Twist the ends of the strip twice. Lay the scarf around your neck and tie it with a knot.

The Pearls... Fold the corners of a square scarf towards the middle. Continue folding the scarf into a narrow strip and twist it fairly tight. Tie a loose knot in the middle of the roll and two more knots in each end about 5 cm from each other. There will be five knots in all, the two nearest the ends being tightest. Tie the ends of the scarf back.

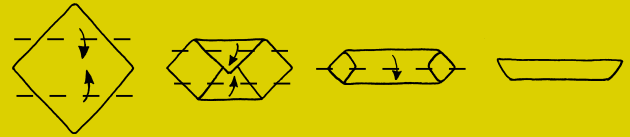
